VISITOR GUIDELINES

1. THAT YOU ARE SURE TO BE THERE. PRE-REGISTER!

Please register online before the event, as registration onsite is not possible. You can either print out your admission voucher, which has a barcode, or bring it on your mobile device. Please note that for your safety, onsite registration is no longer possible. We will make it convenient for you to register for **a specific timeslot** so that we can ensure compliance with crowd density standards, while saving you.

2. CONTACT TRACING - OUR SMART BADGE TECHNOLOGY

Our Smart Badge technology allows you **to visit safely without physical contact**. You will receive your badge at the entrance after your barcode has been scanned.

With the help of your smart badge you can **easily and digitally collect information from all exhibitors**. You get access to product descriptions, pictures, videos or even job offers. The collection of countless brochures and catalogs is no longer necessary. You can also **share all information digitally with colleagues afterwards**.



For the safety of all parties involved (exhibitors, visitors, organizers), the Smart Badge Reader must be touched during every personal contact at the stand. This has the advantage that detailed contact lists (contact tracing) are available in the event of illness, so that all visitors do not necessarily have to be placed in a quarantine, if necessary.

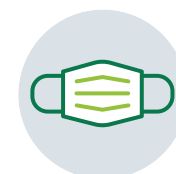
3. SOCIAL DISTANCING AND CROWD MANAGEMENT

We kindly request that you maintain a distance of **at least 1.5 metres from other people**. Clear signage and floor stickers will help you respect this distance. In general, crowd control and queue management techniques will be implemented **to ensure social distancing** is maintained, by means of floor and overhead signage and, wherever necessary, physical measures such as barriers, oneway flows and the support of **our trained staff and a greater number of security personnel**.



4. DURING THE SHOW: FACE MASKS!

Wearing a face mask during the show is mandatory. Faceshields are not allowed. We encourage you to bring your own, but event staff **will be on hand to provide one if you forget!** There will be identified areas without mandatory mask-wearing



No mask required:

- At the Coffee Lounge
- While you are drinking and eating in a Lounge or in a restaurant
- Fresh-Air Areas

5. CLEANING & HYGIENE

Wash and disinfect your hands thoroughly and frequently.

Hand sanitiser stations will be available everywhere on the exhibition floor and in common areas. Please make use of them regularly during the day!

Give a smile instead of a handshake. Sneeze and cough in the crook of your arm.



Due to hygiene regulations, we are unfortunately unable to offer a checkroom for exhibitors and visitors.

6. CATERING: COFFEE AND SNACKS FOR FREE

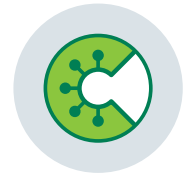
Exhibitors and Visitors will receive Coffee and Snacks for free in the Networking Lounge

For your security we prefer contactless payment on the exhibition grounds.

- You had any contact to a Covid-19 Patient 14 days before the show
- If you feel at all ill – including mild cold symptoms
- You visited any BAG regions at risk 10 days before the show
